

## Verse 105

*N'eva devo na gandhabbo  
na māro saha brahmunā  
Jitam apajitam kayirā  
tathārūpassa jantuno*

Neither a *deva* nor a *gandhabba*,  
nor *Māra*, nor even *Brahmā*,  
can overturn the victory  
of such a person.

### Meaning

<i>n'eva</i>	[ = <i>na</i> + <i>eva</i> ] not indeed
<i>devo</i>	a <i>Deva</i> ( i.e. heavenly being )
<i>na</i>	nor
<i>gandhabbo</i>	a <i>Gandhabba</i>
<i>māro</i>	<i>Māra</i> the evil one
<i>saha</i>	(together) with
<i>brahmunā</i>	<i>Brahmā</i>
<i>jitam</i>	victory
<i>apajitam</i>	defeat (overturn the victory)
<i>kayirā</i>	(would be) done
<i>tathārūpassa</i>	such a (person)
<i>jantuno</i>	person, man
