*Asāre sāramatino  
sāre casāradassino  
Te sāram nadhigacchanti  
micchā sankappagocarā*

The unessential they imagine as essential,  
in the essential they see as unessential,  
they never realize the essence,  
who entertain (such) wrong thoughts.

*Sārañ ca sārato ñatvā  
asārañ ca asārato  
Te sāram adhigacchanti  
sammā sankappagocarā*

What is essential they understood as essential,  
what is unessential they regard as unessential,  
they realize the essence,  
who entertain (such) right thoughts.

<i>gocarā</i>	[ Fig. ] entertain, tend towards, feeding upon
<i>sārañ</i>	(the) essential
<i>sārato</i>	as essential
<i>ñatvā</i>	understood
<i>asārañ</i>	(the) non-essential
<i>asārato</i>	unessential
<i>adhigacchanti</i>	understand
