Meaning

<i>yassa</i>	whoever
<i>pāpam</i>	evil
<i>katam</i>	done
<i>kammam</i>	deed
<i>kusalena</i>	with goodness
<i>pithīyati</i>	covers
<i>so</i>	he
<i>imam</i>	this
<i>lokam</i>	world
<i>pabhāseti</i>	illuminates; shines
<i>abbhāmutto</i>	free from clouds
<i>'va [eva]</i>	just as
<i>candimā</i>	the moon
