Meaning

<i>yathā</i>	just as
<i>sankāra</i>	rubbish
<i>dhānasmim</i>	heap
<i>ujjhitasmim</i>	thrown away; swept out
<i>mahāpathe</i>	[Loc.] on the highway
<i>padumam</i>	lotus
<i>tattha</i>	at that place
<i>jāyetha</i>	born
<i>sucigandham</i>	having a sweet scent
<i>manoramam</i>	delightful and pleasing to the mind
