Meaning

<i>evam</i>	even so
<i>sankāra</i>	[Lit. rubbish] the worthless
<i>bhūtesu</i>	beings
<i>andhabhūte</i>	blind; ignorant
<i>puthujjane</i>	worldlings
<i>atirocati</i>	outshines
<i>paññāya</i>	in wisdom
<i>sammāsambuddha</i>	(the) Fully-Enlightened One('s)
<i>sāvako</i>	disciple
