<i>attana</i>	oneself
<i>karontā</i>	doing, performing
<i>pāpakam</i>	evil, unwholesome
<i>kammam</i>	deed, action
<i>yam</i>	of which
<i>hoti</i>	is
<i>katuka</i>	bitter
<i>phalam</i>	fruit
