

Verse 86

*Ye ca kho sammadakkhāte
dhamme dhammānūvattino
Te janā pāramessanti
maccudheyyam suduttaram*

Those who act in conformity to
the teaching which is well-preached,
will reach the other shore (*Nibbāna*),
having transcended the realm of death
(*Samsara*) which is difficult to escape.

Meaning

<i>ye (ca)</i>	those men
<i>kho</i>	[used here as emphasis] indeed
<i>sammadakkhāte</i>	[<i>sammā</i> + (<i>d</i>) + <i>akkhāta</i>] well-preached
<i>dhamme</i>	the Dhamma
<i>dhammānūvattino</i>	[<i>dhamma</i> + <i>ānūvattino</i>] acting in conformity to the Dhamma
<i>te</i>	they
<i>janā</i>	people
<i>pāramessanti</i>	arrived at the other shore (i.e. <i>Nibbāna</i>)
<i>maccu</i>	death
<i>dheyyam</i>	under the sway of; in the realm of
<i>suduttaram</i>	very difficult to escape from
