Meaning

<i>santam</i>	peaceful; calm
<i>tassa</i>	his
<i>manam</i>	mind
<i>hoti</i>	is
<i>santā</i>	peaceful / calm (too)
<i>vācā</i>	speech
<i>ca</i>	and
<i>kamma</i>	action
<i>sammadaññā</i>	[<i>sammā</i> + (<i>d</i>) + <i>aññā</i>] perfect knowledge
<i>vimuttassa</i>	(he is) freed, emancipated, liberated
<i>upasantassa</i>	(he is) calmed, composed, tranquil
<i>tādino</i>	of such qualities (he has)
