<i>pañcamo</i>	the fifth
<i>chatthamam</i>	sixth
<i>pahūta</i>	abundant
<i>vitto</i>	treasure, property
<i>puriso</i>	man
<i>sahirañño</i>	he has gold
<i>sabhojano</i>	he has food
<i>eko</i>	one(self)
<i>bhuñjati</i>	enjoys
<i>sādūni</i>	(what is) sweet, nice, pleasant
