<i>chatthamo</i>	the sixth
<i>sattamam</i>	seventh
<i>jātitthaddho</i>	proud of one's birth
<i>dhanatthaddho</i>	proud of one's wealth
<i>gottatthaddho</i>	proud of one's clan
<i>saññātim</i>	one's own kinsmen
<i>atimaññeti</i>	slight, despise, show conceit
