<i>navamo</i>	the ninth
<i>dasamam</i>	tenth
<i>atīta</i>	gone past
<i>yobbano</i>	youth
<i>poso</i>	[ = <i>purisa</i> ] man
<i>āneti</i>	bring back, procure
<i>timbarutthanim</i>	[ <b>Figuratively</b> ] a young woman, girl
<i>tassā</i>	he
<i>issā</i>	(due to) jealousy
<i>na supati</i>	cannot sleep
