Meaning

<i>buddha</i>	The Enlightened One
<i>settho</i>	highest, supreme
<i>Buddhassettho</i>	the Supreme Buddha
<i>yam...parivoannayi</i>	such ... praised
<i>sucim</i>	pureness, purity, stainless
<i>samādhim</i>	concentration
<i>ānantarikaññam</i>	without interval/interruption
<i>āhu</i>	they describe/said
<i>tena samādhinā</i>	with that concentration
<i>samo</i>	similar
<i>na vijjati</i>	there is none
